Requests must be made through a local Non-Profit Organization or Church. In the event additional funds are added to the emergency fund, we will distribute those funds on a weekly basis, as needed.

Your request (on the Foundation's form) must be delivered to the Foundation by noon on Friday and will be issued by noon the following Monday. All requests will be evaluated and the Foundation may elect to grant requests in part or whole, depending on availability of funds. Disbursements will be made each Monday beginning on April 20, 2020, and will continue until discontinued by the Foundation.
